

MINNESOTA CITY ORDINANCE NO. 35

(Published Date Tuesday, September 21, 1971.)

Amending Ordinance No. 35 in Village of Minnesota City, Minnesota.

Re: An ordinance licensing and regulating dogs, providing for impounding dogs and prescribing a penalty for violation.

By unanimous vote the Council of the Village of Minnesota City motioned to amend Section 2 of above ordinance to read as follows.

SECTION II. (A) LICENSE REQUIRED.

No dog owner shall keep any dog within the Village after the First day of January, 1972 unless a license therefore has been obtained. Licenses shall be issued by the Village Clerk for a fee of \$3.00 for each male or spayed female dog, and \$5.00 for each unspayed female dog.

(B) No person firm or corporation shall permit a dog to run at large within the Village of Minnesota City.

All other sections and provisions of this ordinance shall remain in effect as originally dated and passed, January 3rd 1967 and published January 9, 1967.
