

ORDINANCE 38

A SPECIAL LICENSE TO SELL LIQUOR ON SUNDAY

The City Council of the City of Minnesota City ordains:

Section 1. LICENSE REQUIRED. That a special liquor license may be granted to the L-Cove Bar and the Oaks Night Club to sell liquor on Sunday from 12 o'clock noon to 12 o'clock midnight.

Section 2. APPLICATION FOR LICENSES. Every person desiring a license to sell liquor on Sunday shall file a verified application therefor in writing with the City Clerk in the form to be prescribed by the State Liquor Control Commissioner and with such additional information as the City Council may from time to time require.

Section 3. FEE. The annual fee for this license shall be \$125.00. No liquor shall be served on Sundays other than to persons who are seated at tables. Each establishment licensed under this ordinance shall have facilities for seating not less than 30 guests at one time, or such greater number as the City Council may determine. No liquor or beer shall be sold to persons under 21 years of age.

Section 4. PENALTY. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00, or by imprisonment for not to exceed 90 days in county jail.

Section 5. EFFECT. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
