ORDINANCE NO. 32

An ORDINANCE

To Amend an Ordinance Entitled, "An Ordinance Providing for the Establishment of a Volunteer Fire Department and Making Rules and Regulations for the Government of the Same."

The Village Council of the Village of Minnesota City, Minnesota, do ordain:

SECTION 1. That Section 1, Section 2, Section 7 and Section 9 of that certain Ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Providing for the Establishment of a Volunteer Fire Department and Making Rules and Regulations for the Government of the Same," passed and approved on July 5, 1951, be amended to read as follows:

"**SECTION 1. Fire Department Established.** There is hereby established a volunteer fire department, hereafter known as the Minnesota City Volunteer Fire Department, consisting of a Chief, an Assistant Chief, a Fire Marshall, not less than seven (7) nor more than twenty-five (25) Active Firemen and not more than twelve (12) Associate Firemen."

"**SECTION 2. Election (Appointment).**

The Chief of the Fire Department shall be elected annually by resident members of the Department at a meeting to be held in April subject to confirmation by the Village Council. The Chief shall be the Fire Marshall and shall appoint an Assistant Chief subject to confirmation by the Village Council. The approval of the Council shall be presumed unless the Council votes to disapprove such action at its regular meeting during the month of May. The Chief, the Fire Marshall, the Assistant Chief and Active and Associate Firemen may each be removed by the Council for cause after a public hearing."

"**SECTION 7. Firemen.** The Chief, the Assistant Chief, Active Firemen and Associate Firemen shall be not less than twenty-one (21) years of age. The Chief, the Assistant Chief and Active Firemen shall be residents of the village of Minnesota City and shall conduct the business and affairs of the Department. Non-resident firemen shall be Associate Firemen and shall not participate in the conduct of the business and affairs of the Department."

"**SECTION 9. Relief Association.** The resident members and officers of the Fire Department may organize themselves into a Firemen's Relief Association."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

ORDINANCE NO. 32

An ORDINANCE

The Village Council of the Village of Minnesota City, Minnesota, do ordain:

SECTION 1. That Section 1, Section 2, Section 7 and Section 9 of that certain Ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Providing for the Establishment of a Volunteer Fire Department and Making Rules and Regulations for the Government of the Same," passed and approved on July 5, 1951, be amended to read as follows:

"**SECTION 1. Fire Department Established.** There is hereby established a volunteer fire department, hereafter known as the Minnesota City Volunteer Fire Department, consisting of a Chief, an Assistant Chief, a Fire Marshall, not less than seven (7) nor more than twenty-five (25) Active Firemen and not more than twelve (12) Associate Firemen."

"**SECTION 2. Election (Appointment).**

The Chief of the Fire Department shall be elected annually by resident members of the Department at a meeting to be held in April subject to confirmation by the Village Council. The Chief shall be the Fire Marshall and shall appoint an Assistant Chief subject to confirmation by the Village Council. The approval of the Council shall be presumed unless the Council votes to disapprove such action at its regular meeting during the month of May. The Chief, the Fire Marshall, the Assistant Chief and Active and Associate Firemen may each be removed by the Council for cause after a public hearing."

"**SECTION 7. Firemen.** The Chief, the Assistant Chief, Active Firemen and Associate Firemen shall be not less than twenty-one (21) years of age. The Chief, the Assistant Chief and Active Firemen shall be residents of the village of Minnesota City and shall conduct the business and affairs of the Department. Non-resident firemen shall be Associate Firemen and shall not participate in the conduct of the business and affairs of the Department."

"**SECTION 9. Relief Association.** The resident members and officers of the Fire Department may organize themselves into a Firemen's Relief Association."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
