

ORDINANCE 40

CURFEW. AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PRESENCE OF PERSONS 17 YEARS OLD OR YOUNGER ON THE STREETS OR IN PUBLIC PLACES BETWEEN 11:00 P.M. AND 6:00 A.M. DUTIES OF PARENTS AND OTHERS IN CARE OF MINORS AND PROVIDING FOR ARREST AND PENALTIES THEREOF.

The City Council of the City of Minnesota City do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any child under the age of 17 years to be on any public street, highway, road, alley or public ground, public building or other public place in the City between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. of the following day; provided, however, that any child under the age of 17 years who is lawfully employed shall be permitted to go to and from the place of his employment during the hours above set forth if required to do so because of his employment upon securing a permit from the Winona County Sheriff's Department. A child under the age of 17 years shall be permitted to be on any public street, highway, road, alley or public ground, public building or other public place in the City between the hours above set forth when such child is in the company of his parents, or legal guardian, or in the company of a person having legal care, custody and control of such child. Any minor violating any provision of this Section shall be taken into custody by a duly authorized law enforcement officer and turned over to the appropriate court of the County to be dealt with under the laws of the state.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor.

ADOPTION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL REPEAL ANY PRECEDING CURFEW ORDINANCE.
